

Minutes of North Bellmore Civic Association on May 9, 2011

After usual opening of the North Bellmore Civic Association Mr. Nunez introduced Police Officer John Barron of the 1st precinct who talked about various reports in our area. He said there were not too many criminal activities in the area at this time.

After the police officer left Mr. Nunez mentioned a proposal to redistricting our area. He had copies of map showing the differences.

Thereafter County Executive Mangano and members of his staff were introduced.

Mr. Mangano then talked about various issues. He mentioned a new prescription drug that is a problem, eliminating the home energy tax, he talked about the property tax system and what he wants to change. He also talked about the technology sector, homeland security bringing various groups together, alternate energy sources, an increase in employment and other problems on the island.

Thereafter Mr. Mangano or members of his staff answered questions asked by people in the audience on various issues such as the army base, reducing taxes, development of the coliseum, the status of Eisenhower pool, transportation for veterans, volunteer drivers, the turn signal at Newbridge Road, police officers with radar near Newbridge Road School, reduced work force, reduced patronage, MTA, the Nassau County Empire State Games for the Physically Challenged, County Environmental Bond Act, etc.

After County Executive Mangano left, Mr. Arthur Goldstein, Superintendent of the North Bellmore School District spoke, giving a detailed talk about how the school budget is determined. Various people asked questions.

The budget was passed on May 17, 2011.
