Meeting Date: February 05, 2006

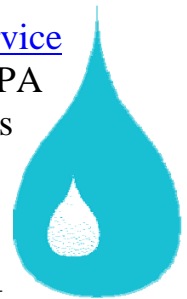

After recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance lead by Chris Szatmary, plus reading minutes of previous meeting by Fran Branca, police officer Ken Murray spoke. First, he introduced police officer Bilello who will speak on different occasions. Mr. Murray talked about the importance of shoveling snow in driveways and on sidewalks. Thereafter, Officer Murray talked about speed limits, speed signs and lights.

Mention was made of a special election on February 28<sup>th</sup> for assembly seat for District 17. Mr. Zahid Ali Syed, union representative for various supermarkets, is a candidate for the Assembly seat. He spoke and listed his qualifications. Then Mr. Tom McKevitt, Deputy Town Attorney, also a candidate, spoke. He explained his background plus various issues that have to be met, such as increase in property taxes. He also recommends increasing the Star Program.

Mr. Reinhardt then talked about former Army Base area. A hearing will be held by the town to discuss changes that the builder wants: to remove community center, pool, and other revisions. He also mentioned that the builder wants to build 82 housing units. Mr. Nunez says he will ask Mr. Kaplan to come to a civic meeting before the town meeting.

Thereafter, Mr. Joe Trotta, Laboratory Director of [New York Water Service Corporation](#), spoke. He gave information on the water company including EPA regulations, what's considered pure, etc. Mr. Nunez asked further questions about pricing rates, quality of water, etc. Mr. Trotta said if person has problem with water, such as rust, call New York Water directly. He also said tap water is just as good as bottled water. He left plastic bottles for people at meeting with cute sign "Quichen Forsett" in which people can put regular faucet water.
