MINUTES

Meeting Date: July 09, 2007

Mr. Podolski introduced himself as the Vice President of the civic association and said President of Civic Association, Mr. Nunez, not able to attend this meeting.

Thereafter minutes of previous meeting were read by Fran Branca.

Mr. Podolski then said nothing new re cell tower. Senator Fuschillo's office will be checking re improvements on Jerusalem Avenue - tree taken down near Chase Bank, and moratorium lifted an ongoing process - re Stop and Shop - short a few parking spaces. And North Bellmore Civic still looking for a fund raiser.

Christine Zsatmary read the names of students who received awards from civic association. The students were invited to the September meeting.

Then Police Officer Glen Newman spoke. Said there were some burglaries and 9 criminal mischief incidents. Said a Crime Prevention Tip is to be more suspicious and if you see something call 911.

There was further discussion about trees, parking problems, rolling with bikes, bikes should have serial numbers, kids jumping over fences, stop sign and traffic, getting new radio towers for police, said all items should be marked, garages should be locked. If you see something call up. Can also call 573-7360 and set up own program.

Mr. Podolski then introduced Pastor Jeanette and architect Monte Leper who discussed what he plans to do re the church in question.

Thereafter many people talked angrily about conversion of a single family residence to a church. Most questions were related to lack of parking, objections to the electric cross, increase in pollution and noise and store.

People also asked questions relating to personal business of minister such as what she lives on, financing the church, and taxes. Lady Minister says mostly lives on social security. Taxes are paid. One goal is homeless shelter at church.

Two ministers spoke in favor of the minister and the church.

John Reinhart spoke about parking, fencing and landscaping re church. Mr. Denenberg spoke about welfare of people living in church area.

Chris Szatmary said there is a variance against cross so why was it not taken down. There was lengthy applause after these remarks. Lady Minister said the cross will be taken down.
