Mr. Schary mentioned building new post office on Jerusalem plus traffic problem re post office. Ms. Branca spoke and said didn't agree that new post office was needed but traffic could be improved. She also said a new Rite Aide not needed but area could be used for condos and co-ops. Suggested people write to their elected officials about this.

Ms. Reinhart commented that Bellmore Plaza Center looks very nice.

Mr. Weinstein spoke and said went to church discussion which he said lasted 9 ½ hours. Both Mr. Denenberg and Mr. Hughes also spoke about church project. No decision as yet.

Mr. Weinstein also mentioned Hess Gas Station wanting to put up new gas station. With regard to Stop and Shop no determination as yet as to when it will close for renovation.

Mr. Denenberg also spoke about Trump restaurant and variance for basement.

Further questions raised re workers at Bell Aire not being union workers. This is something Mr. Denenberg, Mr. Hughes and Mr. Fuschillo should look into.
